What are participles ?

- Words formed from a verb
- Used as nouns or adjectives
- Analyse :

to **boil**

vs.


the **boiled** water

vs.

I am **boiling** water

فِعْلٌ فَاعِلٌ مَفْعُولٌ



Object

Subject

Verb

Active participle (F1)

- Arabic : اسم الفاعل
- On the pattern of فاعل has DING
- Meaning (from context) :
 1. Doer of action
 2. The action itself

How to Active participle

1. Add ا (alif) to the 1st root letter
2. Add a ك (Kasrah) to the 2nd root letter
3. Add ت (Tanween) to 3rd root letter

سَجَدَ ← سَاجِدٌ

Someone doing the action of سَجَدَ

Example (masc.)

Translate	Active pl. m.	Active sg. m.	
Creator / Creating (sg.)	خَالِقُونَ	خَالِقٌ	N
Creators (pl.)	خَالِقِينَ	خَالِقاً	A

Example (femn.)

<i>Translate</i>	Active pl. f.	Active sg. f.	
Creator / Creating (sg.)	خَالِقَاتُ	خَالِقَةٌ	N
Creators (pl.)	خَالِقَاتٍ	خَالِقَةٍ	A G

Passive participle (FI)

- Arabic: إِسْمُ الْمَفْعُولِ
- On the pattern of مَفْعُولٌ has DING
- Meaning :
 - I. Action done to s.th. or s.o.

How to Passive participle

1. Add مَ before the 1st root letter
2. 1st root letter becomes Saakin
3. و added after 2nd root letter

خَلَقَ \Leftarrow مَخْلُوقٌ

The action of خَلَقَ done to s.th. or s.o.

Example (masc.)

Creatures (pl.)	مَخْلُوقَيْنَ	مَخْلُوقاً	A







to be close, depend, administer = ولِيَ \ يَلِيَ
power, strength, authority, dominion = سُلْطَانٌ

وَمَنْ قُتِلَ مَظْلُومًا فَقَدْ
جَعَلْنَا لِوَلِيهِ سُلْطَانًا

And // whoever // is killed // unjustly
We have given // his heir // authority

حرَمَ vs حَرِمَ

١٤ - ٧٠:٢٤

حرَمَ \ يَحْرِمُ = to deprive / dispossess / withdraw / deny / refuse
حرُمَ (يَحْرُمُ) \ حَرِمَ (يَحْرَمُ) = to be forbidden / prohibited / unlawful


وَالَّذِينَ فِي أَمْوَالِهِمْ حَقٌّ
مَعْلُومٌ - لِلسَّائِلِ وَالْمَحْرُومِ

And those // within whose wealth is a known right - For the petitioner and the deprived -

to witness = شَهِدَ / يَشْهُدُ

action being done to sth = مَشْهُودٌ
