- It means “**is not**” and it is used in a nominal sentence.
- It is a sister of كَانَ and will affect the predicate/info in the same way :
 - ✓ Noun of is Nominative ;
 - ✓ Predicate of is Accusative ;
- Works often with a preposition بِ \ لِ \ عَلَى

Predicate of لَيْسَ

Noun of لَيْسَ
