Course Overview (2/2)

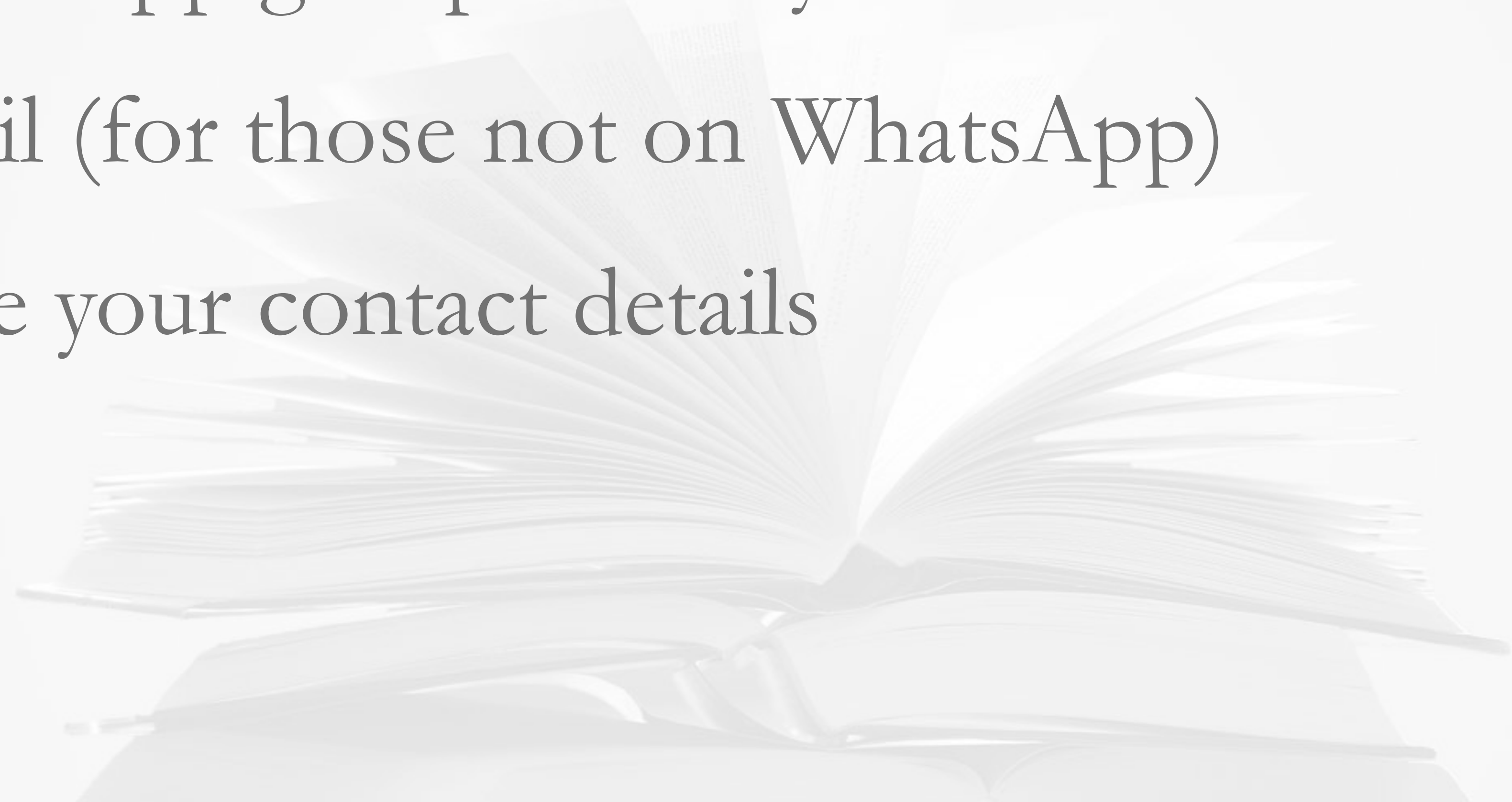
