Pronouns (الضَمَائِرُ) 1/4

There are 2 types of pronouns:

- المُنْفُصِلُ) Detached (المُنْفُصِلُ)
 - which comes separate from verb, noun, particle
 - هِيَ هُمَا هُنَّ •

2. Attached (المُتَّصِلُ)


- which comes attached to a verb, noun, particle
- suffixes / at the end of words

Pronouns (الضَمَائِرُ) 2/4

They can be further categorised into:

I. Nominative

- Subject pronouna. subject of a verb
- more on this after Unit 10



Pronouns (الضَمَائِرُ) 3/4

They can be further categorised into:

2. Accusative

- Object pronoun
 - a. object of a verb which is attached to it

- noun (اٍسْم) of إِنَّ which is attached to it
 - | Indeed you (m.) اِنَّـنِي ا Indeed J (m./f.)

Pronouns (الضَمَائِرُ) 4/4

They can be further categorised into:

3. Genitive

- Possessive pronoun
 - a. attached to a noun, to show ownership/possession
 - his book (کِتَابُ + هُ) کِتَابُهُ
 - کتابُهُمْ (کِتَابُ + هُمْ) کِتَابُهُمْ their book
- attached to a preposition
 - مَلَيْكُمْ \ for you \ عَلَيْكُمْ on you (pl.)

3rd Person

There are two forms for 3rd p. attached pronouns

- If preceding vowel is fat'ha or dammah
 - use dammah on pronoun
- Else if kasrah
 - use kasrah

• Except for which is indeclinable (not change sign)

1. With verb (object)

Attached to verb

Detached from verb

ایّای	Only me	المالية الع	Only you (f.)

Attached Pronouns (Acc.)

2. With particle إِنَّ

عنا	Indeed he	إنْك	Indeed you (m.)

Attached Pronouns (Gen.)

3. With noun (possession)

Attached Pronouns (Gen.)

4. With preposition



وَقف - Waqf


- Stops when reciting اَلْقُرْآن
