


## Nominal Sentence (2/3)

- Starts with a Noun
- مُبتداً are obligatory
- Both are مَرفُوع (Nominative)
- مُبتَداً is mostly Definite
- مُبتَداً agrees with مُبتَداً in ING
- Translate as : أُمُبِتَداً : Translate as

## Verbal Sentence (1/3)



## Verbal Sentence (2/3)

- Starts with a Verb
- Verb and Subject are obligatory
- Subject is مَرفُوع (Nominative)
- Object is مَنصُوب (Accusative)
- Translate as : Subject "did/do" Verb
   "to the" Object

## Verbal Sentence (3/3)



Allah ~ created ~ the pairs / spouses

## المَرْفُوعُ - Nominative

ends with numinative

- I. By Default
- 2. Subject (فاعل): doer of the action (v.s.)
- 3. آغنین : Starter / Beginner (n. s.)
- 4. احْبَر: Information / Predicate (n. s.)

- Object (مَفْعُول) : acted upon by the subject (v. s.)
- 2. Adverb (ظُرُف) : qualifies or modifies a verb (v. s.)
- 3. Particle الن : indeed
  - اسم إن Noun only


- 2. adverb: qualifies or modifies a verb
  - adverb of manner: how it is done
  - he walks quickly
  - adverb of time: now, night, day
  - she worked yesterday
  - adverb of place: here, there
  - adverb of degree (adj): very, quite
  - eats quite slowly





    - 2. predicate: Unit 9
