# الإضافة - Possession phrase

- Literally means "adding"
- There is no « of » or « `s » in Arabic
- Possession is expressed by 2 linked nouns:
  - 1. First noun : ومناف
  - 2. Second noun : مُضَافَّ إِلَيْهِ



- Forget about possessor or possessed
  Both parts together = single structure

# مُضَافً Rules for

- It does not take
  - 1. Definite article J
  - 2. Indefinite article Tanween –
- It is <u>definite</u> by position in the phrase
- Ending can be Nom. / Acc. / Gen.
- If Sound Dual or Plural noun ⇒ loses last ¿
- Its adjective must be definite too

# مُضَافً Examples of

نَارُ	نَارُ		
نصر	نصر		
مُسلِمِی	مُسلِمِينَ		
لثنا	بِنْتَانِ		

# مُضَافً إِلَيْهِ Rules for

- It will be in the Genitive case / مَجْرُور
  - \* I do not say ends with kasrah!

• It can be definite ( ) or indefinite (tanween) Examples:

#### How to translate?

- Just add « of » between the first and second noun
  - \* translating from Right to Left
- The مُضَافٌ, even without الله is translated using "The" (definite by position) and not "A"
- Avoid using the « 's » in English
  - \* e.g. Ahmad's book



# اضافة Examples of

The Fire of Allah	نَارُ اللّهِ
The help of Allah	نَـصْرُ اللَّهِ
The Day of Judgment	يَـوْمُ ٱلـدِّينِ
The book of Ahmad	كِتَابُ أَحْمَدَ
The land of peace	أُرْضُ السَّلامِ

### **Attached pronoun**

Can express possession using attached pronouns

The Messenger of Allah

\* With what can we replace هُوُ or هُوَ = He ⇒ no possession = His ⇒ shows possession

### **Attached pronoun**

His Messenger

Our Lord	رَبْنا	
Their plot	كَيْدُهُمْ	إِنَّهُمْ يَكِيدُونَ كَيْدًا وَأَكِيدُ كَيْدًا وَأَكِيدُ كَيْدًا اللهِ اللهِ اللهِ اللهِ اللهِ اللهِ اللهِ الله
This is your father	هَا أَبُوكَ	9

#### **Attached pronoun**

Case ending is not changed to Kasrah

• Only nouns are Genitive and declinable :

From His Messenger


# ائيُّ = Special words which

Possessor of Majesty and Honour


• These words are مُضَافٌ and the noun following them are مُضَافٌ إِلَيْهِ (Genitive)
