- 1. Arabic verb changes according to subject:
 - Masculine doer must have <u>masculine</u> verb
 - Feminine doer must have <u>feminine</u> verb

قَرَأُ مَاجِدُ

Madjid read

قَرَأْتْ عَايِشَةُ

'Aisha read

2. If subject is a mixed group of male & female \Rightarrow masculine verb is used

The boys and the girls entered the school

3. Attached pronouns to a verb are objects

He took him to the school

My father took me to the market

4. Doer of action is usually "hidden" within the verb, unless specified elsewhere in the sentence

5. Verb can come before or after the subject

6. Plural verbs are only used for <u>human</u>

7. If the subject is plural but <u>non-human</u>, it is considered (grammatically) as being <u>singular feminine</u> (矣)

8. This is a very important concept in Arabic since there is virtually no exception to this rule

8. If the subject is a group of <u>humans</u>, the verb will be singular if the verb comes before the subject

The men entered the masjid/mosque



The girls wrote the letters and then, they went out

8. This rule is only for 3rd person and agrees only in gender (not in number)



ذَهَبَتِ الْبِنْثُ (sg. f.)



9. If the subject is a group of <u>humans</u>, the verb will agree in <u>gender</u> & <u>number</u>, if it comes after the subject



The boys sat in the class

Condition for 3 rd person (humans)	Verb agrees in Gender	Verb agrees in Number	
Verb comes <u>before</u> Subject	✓	X	
Verb comes <u>after</u> Subject



10. This exception is found in Quran and other Classical Arabic texts


- used for rhetoric reasons
